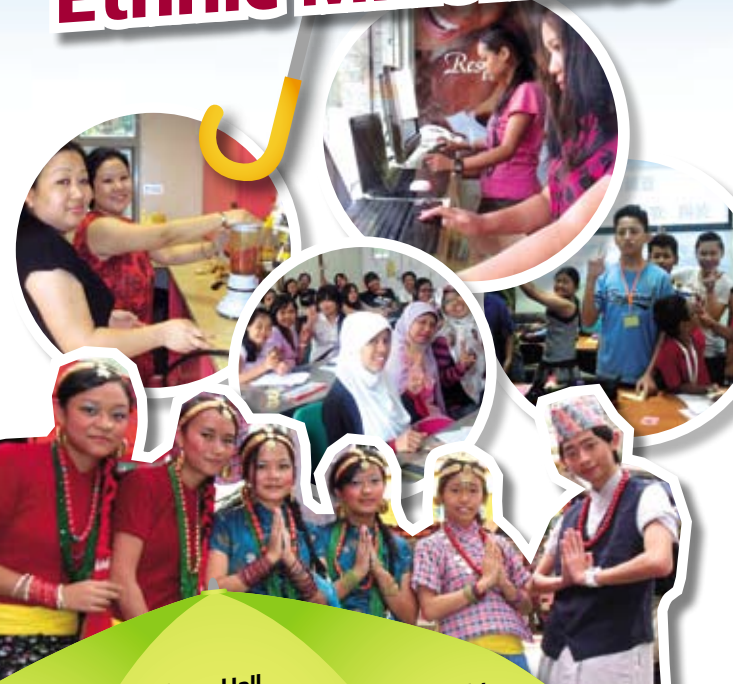
Light Rail
